Help with Zoom

There are many ways of streaming and having a video based gathering. Smaller congregations and groups may be interested to see if Zoom is a possible way for your congregation. A helpful function is the ability to call in by landline phone if a person does not have a computer, tablet or smart phone (video function is the primary base).
