AM Sermon Notes Series in Acts - *The Great Commission in Action* #5 *The Gospel shared beyond the neighbourhood* Acts 8:4 - 25

1. Acts – The Spread of the Gospel

"... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

As the believers proclaim the good news of the risen Lord Jesus, God grows the Church in Jerusalem (Acts 2-5)

As the believers meet, pray, worship and witness, opposition grows and the believers start to scatter, and the good news is shared beyond the neighbourhood (Acts 7 & 8)

2. The Gospel in Samaria Acts 8 i) The great rivalry: Jerusalem & Samaria

ii) Philip in Samaria: proclaiming Christ, signs and wonders – great joy!

iii) Simon the magician: signs and wonders - great confusion!

iv) Peter & John in Samaria - The "Apostolic Blessing"

(Prescriptive vs Descriptive – the unusual situation in Samaria should not be seen as the norm – there are no 2nd class Christians!)

3. The Gospel shared beyond the neighbourhood

Because the Risen Lord Jesus has all authority, there are:

- * no "no-go" areas
- * no barriers
- * no "power sharing" arrangements


