# Sermon Notes 2 Timothy 4:1 – 8 Standing Firm on Truth

### 1. Truth Under Attack - Ephesus

Truth can hurt – exposing our failings; making us feel uncomfortable Christian truth is not always easy to understand, believe and live out – not always palatable

Truth will not always be liked – today, and as it was in the C1st, eg Ephesus What do we know about Ephesus?

In this multi-cultural, multi-religious context, Paul charges Timothy (and us) to stand firm on truth -2 Tim 4:1-8

# 2. Why Stand Firm on Truth?

Paul urges Timothy to keep on with the task of teaching the truth, because

i) it is a most solemn and serious taskv 1ii) it is vital information – the "word" about Jesusv 2

iii) it is for all people on all occasions v 2

iv) false teaching needs to be corrected vv 2 – 4

So, like Paul & Timothy, let us get on with the task vv 5 - 8
