August Mission of the Month: Gyanankur English School



Gyanankur English School is an independent Indian school for Preschool to Year 10 in Kesnand, a village near Pune in India, 4 hours' drive southeast of Mumbai.

The school has a Christian board to oversee it and many Christian teachers. Anne Weeks' friend Melinda Parker, who now lives in Sydney, is the Honorary Director.

This year 3 acres of land has been bought, so plans are underway to build purpose-built innovative classrooms and then move there from their rented school buildings. **Please pray** for all the official steps that must be completed, and for the personnel and funds God is raising up for the building project. **Also, pray for** an Indian Christian (or two) to take over Melinda's role, and for the completion of the new website.

Meanwhile, the 2022-23 school year began in June with a record 800 students! Once again, despite Covid lockdowns shutting the school for 18 months, all students in last year's Yr. 10 passed their exams and graduated.

Some graduates who are now in Yr. 12, university, college or in business have visited the school and shared how special Gyanankur was to them, especially the care that the teachers showed them
